I have converted an Access DB to run on SQL7. I am attempting to create an Access (2002 and 2003) Project to manage this DB. No matter what login I put in the connection properties, I can't Insert or Update records. All options relating to those things are greyed out.

I have connected using:

NT login, default settings

NT login, specific permissions to tables (insert, update, etc)

new SQL login, default settings

new SQL login, specific permissions to tables

new SQL login, DataWriter role (also DataReader, Public, and DBOwner)

I have even tried with the sa account with the same results.
