I am looking for a suggestion to modify the default find tool for my form. In order to search a specific field, you must give that field the focus on the form to run the search. I would like to add code to the default tool so that you can pick which field you want to search using the LookIn combo box. I would paste a picture of what I am talking about but it is restricted. The default find tool allows a search of either the field that has the focus or the entire form. The names of the fields I want to search are FACILITYID and SERIALNUMBER.
