Hi,

I have a subform based on a recordset. I have a boolean column where the user can select the checkbox to the left of the record. If the user selects the checkbox, I want to check to see if the field exactly to the right (DeptID) equals a field on my form. If it does, then that fabulous. If not, then I want to uncheck all boolean values in the table and display a message box. How would I do that?

This is what I have so far and it is giving me the messagebox saying it is the EOF. What should I do differently?
