It's easy enough to do, but why do it? Are you planning to remove Field 1 from your table? If both Field 1 and Field 2 are going to exist in your table, then why not just use a calculated field in query to concatenate them whenever necessary? Like this:

```
SELECT [Field2] & [Field 1] AS WebPage FROM MyTable;
```
