What is the best way to test for corruption and to correct it?

This application, I inherited it from another programmer, has been very buggy and has crashed multiple times. I have not been able to resolve many of the problems and they are on my "To Do" list. This is a complex application with many forms, queries and tables in Access XP. I need it to be stable for client delivery in two weeks and am concerned that the errors and crashes I am dealing with may be related to corruption but I want to be sure before I go down that path.

It does sound like corruption. Did you test it with another control besides the first?

I would try creating a new DB, importing all of the objects into it then try it. You could also make a new form and copy and paste the controls into it a few at a time, testing the dirty property as you do it. The cause could also be a corrupt control.
