I see a lot of posts about conditional formatting, but I'm not sure it can handle what I am trying to do:

1. Field A is a date field. I want to do the following if Field A is between 1/1/2007 and 12/31/2007

- a. Check a check box and lock that check box after it is checked
- b. Locked a bound text field

ELSE

- a. Unlock the check box, allowing the user the option of checking it
- b. Unlock the bound text field
- c. Make the background of the text field pale yellow.

Can I do this with Conditional formatting, and if so, how?

On a continuous or datasheet form, you need to use CF for the color. But you have to use code like the others posted to lock the controls/
