Hi, Im executing an append query to import data into a table. The imported data source has the names in UPPER CASE and I would like to change this upon import to Capital first letter only.

I am going to use the following code for standard data entry

```
Private Sub txtSurname_AfterUpdate()  
If StrComp(Me!txtSurname, LCase(Me!txtSurname), 0) = 0 Then  
    Me!txtSurname = StrConv(Me!txtSurname, vbProperCase)  
End If  
End Sub
```

The If clause ensures that if the user correctly types "MacDonald" or "van Slyke", the program will leave it as entered.
