Based on what I've seen in this group, the SQL is much easier to follow and understand when properly aligned (for example, with a subquery's Select, From, Where, and OrderBy all lined up vertically) I know that Access ignores spaces and new lines in SQL statements, but I'd like to be able to reopen the query window without the formatting being changed.
