All the mdb files I am trying to work with are in the same folder. When I want to look for a 2nd database, Access no longer looks within the same working folder as it did before. It now defaults to:

C:\Documents and Settings\HP_Administrator\Application Data\Microsoft\Access

When I browse and open the correct database, there is no list of tables—it

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is just blank.

I converted this database to Access 2003 from Office 97 last year and it has been working fine until today.

I also noticed that for some reason my entire folder was marked read-only. I just corrected it, but still have the problem.

I installed the SP3 Hotfix today, but my problem is not solved.

Any suggestions?

I am trying to run an append query, both new & old without success. It just started today & I have not made any changes to my Access Options. When I want to append to a table within the same database--no problem. When I want to append to a table from another database, the default

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folder location to
find the database has
changed. When I browse
and indicate the correct mdb
file, the list of tables does
not appear—the pull down
list is blank. I
have compacted & repaired
without success.
