Yes, it is possible. If the qty value is available, VB code can find it and adjust the number of times that record is printed. It would be similar to printing labels with multiple copies. There is a sample in a Microsoft Knowledge Base article that shows how to print multiple labels or skip used labels on a sheet. You will need to modify this to adjust the copy value for each record.
