Open a new query
Select your table
Select the fields SalesPersonNumber, Sale Amount
Select View: Totals from the menu
Under Sale amount select Sum
Under SalePersonnumber select GROUP BY
Enter the following in the field block
IIF(Paid,[Sale Amount],0)
Select SUM in the total block
Enter the following in the next field block,
Sum(IIF(Paid,[Sale Amount],0)/ Sum([Sale Amount])
Select Expression in the total block

Try running this query. IF it gives you the desired results, use it as the source of a report.

PercentCollected
FROM [Your Table]
GROUP BY SalesPersonNumber
```
