- > It sounds like you have setup a password for the ADMIN user in your default
- > workgroup.

- > You will either need to enter the password, or recreate your workgroup file.
- > If you don't have a backup, you can actually delete (or move safely to
- > another folder) the system.mdw. When you start Access it will build a new
- > one. I believe this may prompt you for the install disks in some cases, so
- > make sure you have them handy.
