I hope that you have followed the necessary steps to secure your database. You don't just go into the security menu and start adding users/groups.

Setting a password for the Admin user is what causes the login dialog to appear. Please explain what you mean by 'database had a hissyfit'.

You need to set a password for the Admin user to get the login back.

Start your database using the secure workgroup file you created (you did this, right?). You'll get no login, but you'll be using the correct workgroup file. Go to Tools, Security, Accounts and click on Change Password tab – set a password for this user (which should be Admin).
