Hi,

I administer a database in which the permissions have been "messed up" by another administrator. I need to reset the permissions for all objects in the database, but there are so many user created queries this is a daunting task.

The user group level permissions have been properly applied to the backend tables, but there are so many user created queries that reassigning permissions on these objects is a daunting task.

If I give all user groups read/write/edit/delete access to all queries, will the permissions set on the tables in the back-end override the queries (and keep users out of data they shouldn't be in?)
