

Re: Read only issue

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As far as I know, all the files copied to a CD will be marked as read-only. When copy it back to your HD, it'll still keep the readonly attribute. Untick the readonly attribute from file/property popup should fix the problem.

As for why you can't uncheck the readonly attribute, my guess are:

1. The login user don't have the privilege to change it
2. The media the file is saved on is readonly, eg. on a CD.
