Your Form-Costs is based on Table-Costs then the textboxes IDProcess and Process should be writing to those fields in Table-Costs. This presumes these textboxes are created by selecting them and dragging them over from the field list when the Form is in design view.

If you added the textboxes unbound, without using the field list, then they go nowhere.

If you want to be writing to the fields IDProcess and Process of the Table Process – then your Form Costs needs to be based upon a query that joins those two tables.
