i would have something like

tblemployee
Employeeid, autonum
LastName, text
FirstName, text
DateHired, date/time
ApprenticeLevel, text or number depending on format of field
PreviousRate, currency
CurrentRate, currency
DateofRaise, date/time
ApprenticeSchoolStartDate, date/time
ApprenticeSchoolEndDate, date/time
Comments, memo or text depending on length

tbljobsite
jobsiteid, autonum
Jobsitename, text
employeeid, number
ProjectLeader, yes/no

if you want to track the pay increases over time not just the last pay increase you need another table

tblpay
payid, autonum
employeeid, number
PreviousRate, currency
CurrentRate, currency
DateofRaise, date/time

so you would stick everyone in the employee table including project leaders i added the ProjectLeader, yes/no field to job site but this is only useful if an employee can be both a project leader and a normal employee on another site. if this is not the case then the projectleader, yes/no would be added to the employee table instead.
