>I have a SBS2000 network with XP Pro clients. Been
>running fine with not problems for many months. Now,
>when a user changes their domain password, the machine
>seems to continue to login to the domain OK but the user
>can't access any network services (Outlook, Web via ISA
>server) without getting prompted by these services for
>username and password. For example, when opening
>Outlook, she gets a login prompt with her SBS2000
>username and domain filled in, she fills in the new
>password she just changed to, and Outlook opens. Same
>thing with ISA server. Hit IE, get prompted for a login,
>put in new password, goes through OK. Seems like the
>client may still be trying to submit the old password as
>part of the initial authentication. I need help!
