Have you got NetBIOS over TCP/IP enabled? (Look under TCP/IP advanced, then WINS tab.) Network Neighbourhood actually requires NetBIOS to work!!

> *I'm missing computers from my Network Neighborhood / My Network*
> *Places. These computers are on the network (one is a new XP PRO SP2*
> *machine just added to the network, and another culprit is a 2000 Pro*
> *attached via VPN). We're running DNS and WINS on SBS 2000, and the*
> *computers have been added to the domain.*
>
> *Furthermore, the SBS 2000 Domain Controller can browse to both*
> *computers (yes even over the VPN) and no firewalls are running on*
> *either machine.*
>
> *Both machines are in the list of computers under Active Directory*
> *Users & Computers.*
>
> *We have a single Windows 2000 SBS server. It's set to the Master*
> *Browser via that registry key (IsMasterBrowser). When I run Browstat*
> *on one of the machines, it does indicate that it holds the Master*
> *Browser position of authority.*
>
> *WINS and DNS are running on this machine, and seem to be functioning*
> *reasonably normal (although is there anything I should look for*
> *here?).*
>
> *The SBS 2000 is not the DHCP server...(DHCP is done by a Linksys*
> *router)..*

> *Does anyone have any clues why these computers wont appear? It's*
> *affecting my ability to roll out software (such as Symantec AntiVirus*
> *9.0 which appears to use the Master Browse list to give you the list*
> *of computers you're allowed to install to)*
