- > becuase
- > I am attempting to install McAfee ProtectionPilot on my SBS.
- > According to McAfee support I must deinstall all instances of MSDE
- > since the ePolicy Orchistrate database instance was created in the
- > SQL Server 2000 database and there is no method to change the
- > connection string for the ProtectionPilot agent server.
- >
- > I deinstalled SharePoint and SBS Monitoring and attempted to
- > reinstall them, hoping to have the option of specifying SQL Server. I
- > do not see in the installation process for either SharePoint or
- > Monitoring where I can specified the database to use.

Once installed you can upgrade the Sharepoint MSDE to a full SQL database.  
You cannot upgrade the SBS monitoring database.

Can you give me the connection string of this McAfee stuff? I wonder if  
there is a smarter solution to this.
