> Yes, you need these things -- but not for the reasons you're looking at it.

> I strongly suggest that you run an antivirus software that's designed specifically for SBS ... as it will provide real time scan of incoming email. Trend and others also include both anti-spam and some anti-spyware filtering as well.

>

> The key thing here is that since all email and all data come in thru your server, you want to filter that stuff out sooner, rather than later.

> if you are only relying on the virus and spam protection on a workstation, what happens when someone brings in a laptop that does not have an up to date virus software, connects to your network and spreads a virus or worm?
