I am assuming that you have WSS installed on this server, but have excluded the path for your web service. If that is the case, then the root web.config for your site is setup to run the site in medium or low trust (I think it is actually a custom WSS level). You will need to change this, or override it in your web.config for the web service to a level that allows SQL permissions.
