> programs).
>
> My BT orchestration is sending an XML file via FTP to an HPUX box.
>
> I have access to 2 different HPUX servers which appear to be same OS level
> (uname -a returns same response).
>
> On both servers, the file is transferred nicely.
>
> On one server, BT fails to issue a "quit" command. This keeps the session
> open on the unix box.
>
> Has anyone seen this before and do you know why this is happening?
>
> I found a potential explanation on msdn, but that appears to be tied to BT
> 2004 without SP1 which we apparently have installed.
>
