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Hi Dan,

Since you've mentioned, you've given full permission to "Everyone", I assume you got rights to setup permission for the FTP folder.

Have you tried setting permission to the specific user account you specify in the FTP adapter configuration page (Property: user name).

This is what I figured out about "Everyone" group:

The Everyone group represents everyone known to the Web server (FTP Server as well). This group includes anyone who presents credentials to the Web server or who could successfully log on to the Web server anonymously. In Windows 2000, the anonymous token is part of the "Everyone" group, but its not in Windows Server 2003.
