This, from Microsoft documentation, might help:

adDate(7) Indicates a date value (DBTYPE\_DATE). A date is stored as a double, the whole part of which is the number of days since December 30, 1899, and the fractional part of which is the fraction of a day.

adDBDate(133) Indicates a date value (yyyymmdd) (DBTYPE\_DBDATE).
