If you're using a RichTextBox to display the contents, you can get the RTF string and store it to the SQL database. ADO is the component you use to get data from the database. You can bind a control to the Recordset field. Since this is a program developed in InfoPath, I suggest you post this in microsoft.public.office.developer.vba and microsoft.public.infopath newsgroups. There will be more professionals that can help you on this issue.
