Whenever I try I get this error" The setup routines for the Microsoft Access Driver (\*.mdb) ODBC driver could not be found. Please reinstall the driver."

Upon clicking ok that error is quickly followed by "Component not found in registry".

How do I reinstall these drivers?  
And how did I screw up so badly to begin with?

I have this error with every ODBC entry I have on this system.
