Only happens on windows XP (not sure but may only happen on SP2)

Although giving a code example would be difficult, some background might help

On the launching of our application (VC++ MFC App) we create a CDatabase object that opens a connection to a SQL server database using a DSN. This connection is kept open for the lifetime of the application. The problem seems to come that at a random time in the evening (sometime after 6pm) the software reports the above error when accessing the database. Could this be that pc's network connection has somehow been disrupted thus invalidating the connection?
