I'm trying to execute potentially hundreds of stored procs in SSIS and I'm trying to find an efficient way to do that with out coding the execute sql task individually...i'm hoping I can pass the proc name into another proc which genereates the sqlcmd syntax and have it fire off from there...problem is i may need to return parameters from the procs...

OK, since I haven't used SSIS, I'm out. I would suggest that you try microsoft.public.sqlserver.dts. I think there is an Integration Services group as well, but these new groups seems to have poor distribution and low traffic. In worst case, you will have to try the web forums on forums.microsoft.com.
