Dim cn As New OleDbConnection, _
strConn As String

AddHandler cn.InfoMessage, AddressOf OleDbInfoMessage

' Connection string, change server and database!
strConn = "Provider=SQLNCLI;Integrated Security=SSPI;"
strConn &= "Data Source=(local);Initial Catalog=tempdb"

Try
cn.ConnectionString = strConn
cn.Open()
Catch ex As Exception
Console.WriteLine(ex.Message, "Connection failed!")
cn = Nothing
Exit Sub
End Try

Dim cmd As OleDbCommand = cn.CreateCommand()

cmd.CommandType = System.Data.CommandType.Text
cmd.CommandText = "CREATE DATABASE nisse"
cmd.ExecuteNonQuery()
