Hi All,

I am using snetcfg for my intermediate driver installation. "snetcfg -l .\netsf.inf -c s -i passthru" is what i am using for my intermediate driver installation. But what happens is when i installed the driver for the first time it is working fine. And after uninstalling when i try to install the driver, it is prompting for the sys file path. If i locate the sys file, it installs the driver. It happens with all the machines that it does not require user intervention for the first time, and after that if try to install, it requires user to locate the sys file.

The message box says "the driver passthru.sys on Microsoft Passthru Driver Disk is needed". Then i commented SourceDisksNames section. But still i am getting the same message. I am using it on windows XP with service pack 2.

Can anyone help me how to resolve this issue?
