Dear Experts,

I have developed a custom UsbUart Driver for FTDI UsbUart Device. I developed the driver using KMDF framework. If I use Two INF files One for USB device and the other for COM port on USBUART device, Then the installation succeeds. But I want to install this virtual comport driver using a single Inf file. I don't have anything at USB end to do. My device appears in Device Manager as Virtual Com Port in MSPorts Tab. If I try to install the device using only one Inf file I am getting Error code 39. I don't understand what is the problem If I use only one inf.

Can anybody suggest me how to install my driver using a single Inf file.
