I would like to execute a program *\*only\** from RAM. IE: the program is loaded and manipulated in RAM, *\*never saved to the actual disk\** – and then executed.

I believe this is possible if I use a RAM drive, but I am not familiar with that, and have been unable to locate anything on the web that directly explains how to accomplish what I want.
