Are you specifying the right server DN?

I am not sure why you can't run OutlookSpy and see if GetMailboxTable succeeds. Where does your code run? On the server (with Exchange version of MAPI) or Outlook?

There is nothign vague about the MAPI_E_INVALID_ARG – it says that it did not like the parameters, it cannot possibly say what exactly was wwrong with them.

I don't think it is documented anywhere.
What is your customer's configuration (version of MAPI, Outlook, Exchange, etc).
Frankly speaking I have not seen MAPI_E_INVALID_ARG error returned from GetMailBoxTable – I have seen MAPI_E_NETWORK_ERROR or an outright access violation, but not MAPI_E_INVALID_ARG.
Are you sure it is not really an invalid argument that you pass to GetMailBoxTable?
