Which protocol/service preferred by admins?

- RPC (but W32 Blaster Worm uses vulnerability in RPC)
- Named Pipe (but not available if file and printer sharing is disabled)
- TCP/IP (but in general admin have to open ports firewall manually)
- SNMP
- SSL
- SSH
