I need to check the headers fo my email using smtp/pop3

When bind'ing to a mail server I get bind error:

h=gethostbyname("mail.whatever.fi");
service.sin_addr.s_addr=inet_addr(inet_ntoa*((struct in_addr *)h->h_addr));
service.sin_port=htons(110);
if (bind(mylistens, (SOCKADDR*)&service, sizeof(service)) == SOCKET_ERROR)
{
  blah blah error here
}
....
```
