Hi all

I just installed a brand new DIVA Analog 4 PCI on my XP computer.  
The installation of the System Release 8.5WIN was easy (much easier then the Dialogic SR 5.1.1 for the other cards ...)  
I used my test application that plays WAV files over the TAPI driver.  
The card immediately picked up an incoming call and played my test voice file (PCM 8kHz, 8 bit, mono).  
The sound quality however is very bad :-(  
On the Dialogic D-4PCI I had to increase the sampling rate to (PCM 11025, 16bit, mono) for a decent voice quality. Is there a default (best quality) setting on the Diva too ? Are there any other settings to consider ?
