1. I have an XP Pro machine (A), and a Windows 2000 Standard Server (B).
 2. I login both machine using the my domain account, which is administrator of both machines.
 3. I execute WBEMTest.exe running on an A to run a query against B.
 - . Namespace: \\B\root\cimv2
 - . Query: SELECT * FROM Win32_OperatingSystem
 - . Method: Asynchronous
 4. The query runs without giving any error message, however, no result is returned. (Operation in progress...)
 5. I run the same test using Synchronous / Semisynchronous mode, they both work fine and return me something.
