I have a SQL Server 2000 Stored proc which creates a temp table and does a select on that to return the result set.

example:

[code]

```
create table #tmptable(afield varchar(255))
```

```
<insert values in to table>
```

```
select * from #tmptable
```

```
drop table #tmptable
```

[/code]

However when using this with a datatable, the datatable is always empty. if i create a "real" table it works perfectly.

Any ideas why or how to get around this?
