Just applied SP1 for the v1.1 of the .NET Framework, and we're running into an error while trying to manually enlist SqlConnection in a Distributed Transaction (EnlistDistributedTransaction method). We're receiveing the following error message:

The code is running on a Windows 2000 Server, with Service Pack 4 installed. I've only noticed one other post about this, but it was in regards to using the ServiceDomain class on a Windows 2000/XP box. We're not utilizing the ServiceDomain class nor are we running on Windows 2003.
