I realize my other post was a bit lengthy, so i'd like to repost this question.

Developing VS2005, SP1, .NET 2.0, VB Windows form program on WIN XP Pro, SP2. It has a Dataset with two tables using an SQL 9.0 Server Express.

After creating a new database from the VS server explorer, it seems that the new database always resides in \C:\Program Files\Microsoft SQL Server\MSSQL.1\MSSQL\Data.

When i create the datasource, it asks if i want to copy it to my project. If i answer yes, i cannot update the database.

How do i move the database to another location?
