Hi James,

Thanks for the followup and your understanding. Yes, from your further description, I've got that what you need is actually a easy to use and also encapsulated control rather than a certain control with lots of scripts which makes the application or page hard to maintain. Also, the problem does be caused by the IE's clientside behavior for such list html elements.

Currently we can use some scripts to display the selectedItem's Text in a certain div or layer, if you want a more encapsulated (easy to maintain), you can consider build a custom WebControl which derived from the DropDownList and the scripts can be embeded into the control's code. In fact, this is just what the ASP.NET webservice control Model provide us. :)
