Hello Stephane,

I think what Bruce and Steven suggested is to revise the setting of Linux box with Squid 2.5 in server side. You don't need to change each client's settings.

There is no easy way to change the default naming conventions in asp.net. You can write customized HTTP handler to deal with that in theory. However, that is a time consuming work.

So I suggest you try the above method first to see if it could resolve the problem. If the problem still happens, please reply to this thread and we will follow up here.

Also, I visited www.mls.ca and clicked advanced search. However, it seems that I can't reproduce the problem here. Could you please paste here detailed repro steps?
