On a local website but i want to access data on a remote drive (a mapped drive). The data are Foxpro files on a directory of a mapped drive.

I have a problem with security (no tabel can be opened error 52 in foxpro)

I search the web for a solution.

Server 1 = Windows 2000 (Webserver) and server2 = database server (NT server)

The two server belong to the same domain.

i created a user on the databaseserver (domainserver) who has administrator rights .

On the webserver

I already used impersonate="true" in the config.web file

I added this new user on the webserver

and in the IIS : anonymus is set on with this new created user with his password

ON the DatabaseServer

the database files themselves have full control for the user created.

But still get no rights

Does anyone know what i am doing wrong ?
