

# Re: ASP.NET 1.1 not working on Domain Controller

There are a couple of things you need to look at:

1. When you move up to DC, many directories are locked down tightly. One that is paramount to ASP.NET is having the ability to write temp files in the directory "%WINDIR%\Microsoft.NET\Framework\v1.1.4322\Temporary ASP.NET Files". If this is not read/write to the ASP.NET worker process, you are fried.

2. Certain types of updates will unlink ASP.NET from IIS. aspnet\_regiis /i works wonders in these cases.

That is what I remember off hand. I noticed Ken and a few others have joined the fray, so we have a good knowledge base starting.

NOTE: It is not recommended to install .NET apps on a DC.
