Dexter,

What error is being generated? How are you currently trying to do the insert? Are you attempting to execute a string? Are you using a stored procedure? If you are executing a string, you may be experiencing errors related to characters such as a single quote that interrupt the SQL string. It would be safer for you to use the SqlCommand object and define a parameter with a specified type such as SqlDbType.Text or SqlDbType.VarChar (depending on your needs). Then set the parameter's value property to the HTML and give that a shot. The SqlCommand object will make assumptions and handle some of the data that would normally be invalid when executing a string.
