

Help: IIS no longer running after SP2 and VS.NET 2005

Hi,

I had IIS running perfectly on my WinXP Pro laptop. It also had VS.NET 2002. Some time before my trip I removed VS.NET 2002, installed SP2 for WinXP, installed the Microsoft Web Studio 2005 Beta/trial. Then I installed VS.NET 2003 as well.

The problem is, now I am unable to do any webdevelopment on the machine! I have a couple of web projects installed with their web sharing folders properly set.

Now when I load the project on Visual Studio it is unable to connect with the server.

Pointing my browser to <http://localhost/MyWebFolder> fails with "Page not found or DNS error".

Checking the Task Manager I don't see any IIS process running.

I tried restarting IIS (as admin user) and it gives no error yet there is no IIS running after the "restart".

I do however see the following on the Event Viewer:
