> Settings instead of usual bin folder under the project directory.

> When I go to the project's properties and try to change the path to the
> output folder back to where it always was, I get a message that the output
> path must be in the project directory. Well, it is in the project
> directory.
>
> What happened? How can I fix this? Now when I copy a project to the web
> server, I copy the old dlls, unless I copy them manually.
>
> I guess this happened when for another reason, unknown to me, I've lost
> the
> ability opening my project using the file share, so I started to open this
> particular project using FP extensions. I don't know whether both issues
> are
> related to each other, but both started approximately at the same time.
