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Hi!

The "mixed mode" has nothing to do with VS. You can specify this option during the installation process of your sql-server. You can setup "mixed mode" with your Enterprise Manager on an existing installation of SQL-Server.

Open Enterprise Manager, right-click on the server you want to setup and choose settings. Open the tab "Security" and choose "SQL Server and Windows" under Authentication.

You now can setup any user for the database (e.g. sa) with a password to use this information in future for a database connection.
