Whilst were on the subject, we had a situation recently where an application was not releasing connections back into the connection pool, even though we were calling both .close and .dispose. I'm afraid I dont have any more details to hand, but I do know one of our developers spent a week on the problem, eventually giving in and turning off connection pooling on the server.

Has anyone come across this?
